**General Business:**

- **Rounds in a tour event.** Mario Cerniar from Christchurch proposed more 4 round tournaments to give travellers more time on the course. NZDG would encourage 4 rounds or even 4 rounds plus super 6 but ultimately it's a TD's decision.
- **More un-seeded rounds** – it was suggested that maybe the first two rounds of events be un-seeded to give up and coming players more opportunity to play with the pro's. Once again this was left up to event TD's to make their own decision on.
- **Women's Match Play Championships** – Bob put forward the motion that the Top 4 women on the National Rankings compete in the annual National Match Play Championships. Moved & Carried.
- **TD's and NZDG Exec Members must respond to correspondence.** Dates will be suggested by the end of June each year so the tour calendar can be in place by the end of July. [Before an event is confirmed a pencil booking must be made with the respective council for the intended park.]
- **PDGA C-Tier events** – The PDGA require the information well in advance for the next years calendar.

- **PDGA membership.** Bob asked *as the New Zealand PDGA coordinator* for players to renew their annual PDGA membership ASAP. And any new members to join ASAP as well. Those wanting to play Worlds this year must be members.
- **Trophies.** Martin de Hass raised the point that a lot of names and dates are missing from trophies

It was agreed that for the annual 'NZDG Nationals' the engraving will be covered by NZDG. Plus NZDG Funds will be used to update all trophies to the end of 2007 then TD's must build the cost for trophy engraving into the tournament fee.
